Washington State History Online Course

June 21-August 2, 2017 ~ OR ~ June 5-August 1, 2017*

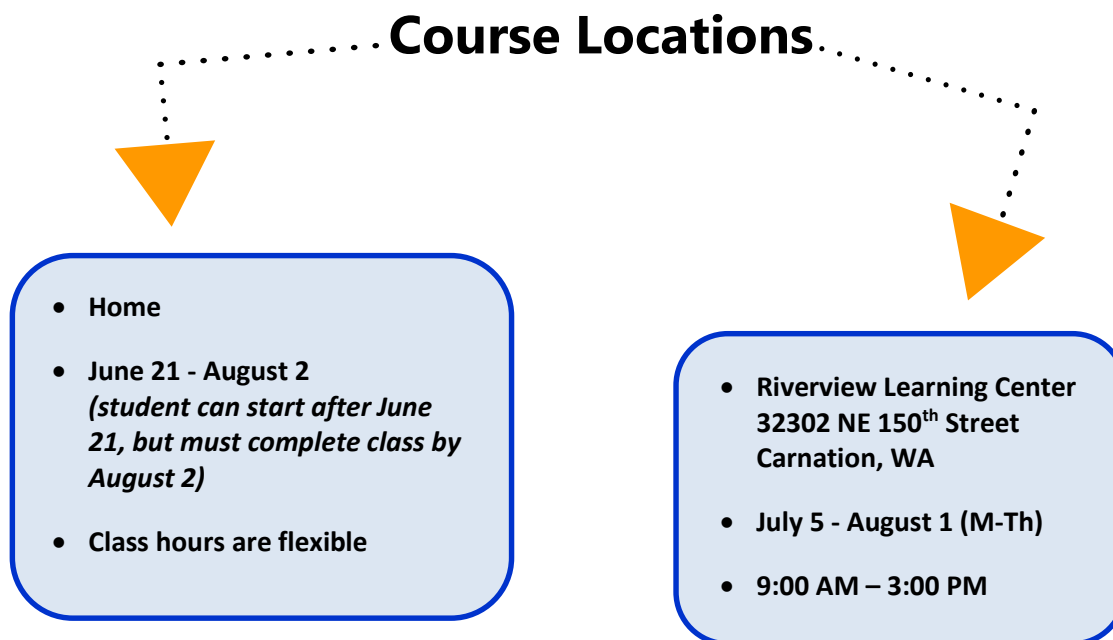
The Summer School program is an opportunity for students to continue learning and working towards academic success and our goal of college readiness.

This Washington State History course is available online to students in 8th grade or above (as of June 2017) who need to make up the .5 credit. Counselor approval is recommended for students who plan to enroll in this course.

The online course is being offered through the Spokane Virtual Learning (SVL) program. SVL is a web-based educational project of Spokane Public Schools that provides instructor-led online courses to students. SVL presents students with an interactive learning experience, not a textbook online.

Tuition/registration must be submitted to SVL no later than 3:00pm on June 23. (See instructions on following page.)

** Students may take the online course from home, or on-site at Riverview Learning Center. **Course dates will differ, depending on the location, as shown below.***

General Information

- **Tuition/registration must be submitted online to SVL by 3:00pm on June 23.**
- Tuition is \$120.
- Successful completion of the class will be subject to teacher/instructor assessment of student progress.

Attendance Policy / Behavior

- With the fast pace of the program, full participation is a mandatory component for credit retrieval.
- Students may not attend class unless registration and tuition have been submitted by June 23.
- Plan vacations around Summer School dates. Make-up work will not be given to students on vacation during Summer School.
- Students who accumulate more than two absences will be withdrawn from the program, **will not earn credit, and tuition will not be refunded.**
- An absence is defined as missing more than 20 minutes of class time. Punctual attendance is essential.
- Students with excused absences will be allowed to make up the work.
- Summer School students are held to the same standards of conduct as Riverview students are during the school year.

Special Services

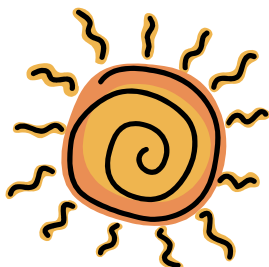
- The Summer School program does not have any Special Education classes or support services.
- If your student is on an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan, it is important that you consult with his/her counselor prior to enrolling.

New Students

New students must include a copy of their current Immunization Form.

Transportation

District transportation is not provided. Parents and students are responsible for safe transport to and from Summer School.

- Submit the tuition payment/registration online to Spokane Virtual Learning (SVL) **by 3:00pm on June 23.** (See instructions below.)
- Complete and submit the Riverview School District registration form **by June 23.**

Registration and Tuition

- **Tuition payment/registration must be submitted online to SVL by 3:00pm on June 23.**

- Enter the information required
- Click on Sign Up

- For School, select Spokane Virtual Learning

- Click on Buy
- Once you have made your class selection, select Checkout at the top right of the screen
- Verify the information in Your Cart
- Click on Checkout Step 1: Additional Info

- Enter your payment information
- Click on Pay Now
- Retain the receipt for your records
