The Riverview School District Board of Directors held a Board Work Study on January 6, 2017, at the Raging River Café in Fall City, Washington.

Present: Carol Van Noy, Jodi Fletcher, Sabrina Parnell, Danny Edwards, and Dr. Smith

Ms. Van Noy began the meeting at 7:00 AM.

The Board discussed the following:

1. Superintendent Evaluation

- *Discussed evaluation and directed superintendent to make a 1-point adjustment in the final evaluation bringing it to distinguished.*
- *Superintendent requested moving to a Focused Evaluation for next school year and also recommended a schedule of one year on focused and the next year on comprehensive. This underscores the importance of the superintendent position to the district as other evaluation cycles go three years on focused and one year on comprehensive, except for beginning teachers and administrators.*

2. Legislative Conference

- *Superintendent updated the board on plans to complete a draft brochure in time for the work study for the Legislative Conference.*

3. Director of Teaching and Learning Resignation

- *Roni Rumsey resigned so the superintendent is working with HR to update the job description, begin recruiting and posting for the job sometime in February.*

4. Bill Adamo Exit Interview (Executive Session) and Recognition (February 14th)

- *Bill Adamo's Exit Interview with the school board is scheduled for 6:00 on February 14th.*
- *We discussed the hiring process, have already welcomed Ruby Perez, our new Director of Business and Operations, and are looking forward to celebrating Bill Adamo's successful 12.5 years and Ruby's entrance into Riverview. She starts on Monday, January 9th, which will give her over a month to job shadow Bill and learn about systems for a seamless transition.*

5. Board Appreciation Month and Board Dinner (Sabrina): What had been done in the past, and what our feelings are about the scholarship gift, what type of acknowledgement we would prefer for the occasion, etc.

- *Sabrina Parnell reported that she and Theresa Tenney communicated and the PTSA wanted feedback on what the School Board would like for recognition. The School Board thought the idea of a dinner where PTSA Council Members could interact with School Board Members would be a good idea. This will occur from 6:00-6:45 prior to the School Board meeting on January 28th. Sabrina Parnell will get back to Theresa Tenney about it.
