

STUDENT HEALTH

The superintendent will arrange for health services to be provided to all students. Such services will include but not be limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records;
- B. Emergency care plans for students with life-threatening conditions (allergies, asthma, cardiac conditions, diabetes, and seizures)
- C. Individual health plans for medically complex students (tube feedings or insulin pumps)
- D. Student health assessments as requested by school staff, administrators, teachers or parents/guardians
- E. Supervision, training, and support of health room personnel
- F. Consulting services of a qualified health specialist for staff, students and parents;
- G. Vision and hearing screening;
- H. Immunization records and screening.
