Administration of oral medication to students as authorized by Chapter 195, Laws of 1982, states: "If a student must receive prescribed oral medication during the school day, the parents/guardians shall provide in writing authorization, instructions, and a description of possible medication side effects to the school principal." Procedures further state that "prescribed medication must be received and stored in the original container in a locked cabinet and dispensed in accordance with instructions from the parents/guardians and licensed health care provider."
