

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**Riverview Education Association (“Association”)**

**Elementary Classroom Teachers – Time for Grading**

The Riverview Education Association and the Riverview School District share an interest in recognizing the time needed in the 2017-18 school year to implement the newly designed report card that resulted from the work of the REPORT CARD COMMITTEE Memorandum of Understanding in the 2016-2019 collective bargaining agreement. Those teachers affected in Section 8.2.4 will receive training and have the opportunity to provide feedback as part of the implementation during the 2017-18 school year.

As the result of Section 8.2.4 – Elementary Classroom Teachers – Time for Grading, the parties therefore agree to revise this section as stated below:

Section 8.2.4 – Elementary Classroom Teachers – Time for Grading

Regular education Kindergarten through Grade 5 classroom teachers, excluding special education teachers, ELL, LAP and Title teachers, elementary physical education teachers, music teachers, and Library Media Specialists, will be granted a ~~three hundred and fifty dollar (\$300)~~ two hundred dollar (\$200) stipend for time devoted to preparing student progress reports and assessments for the second semester.

~~No later than two weeks from the date of submission of the Elementary Report Card Committee’s report, the parties will review the report.~~ Either party may submit for bargaining the issue of said stipend for the remainder of the term of the contract. If agreeable to the Riverview Education Association and the Riverview School District, said stipend can remain as stated above, be revised, or be allowed to expire prior to the end of the current contract.
